

## **CODE OF ETHICS**

PREAMBLE: The Camosun College Faculty Association developed and approved this aspirational code as a guide to the ethical conduct of its members. The code is not, and cannot be, exhaustive; its statements are general in nature to be interpreted and applied in particular situations.

- 1. TERRITORY: We acknowledge the traditional territories of the Coast and Straits Salish peoples.
- 2. INTEGRITY: We create a climate of respect and integrity by treating everyone with consideration and in a fair and just manner. We avoid conflicts of interest and respect the professional autonomy and academic freedom of fellow employees. We are cognisant of and do not exploit our power.
- 3. DIVERSITY: We honour the diversity and individuality of all members of the College Community and promote an environment free from discrimination and harassment.
- 4. ENGAGEMENT: We contribute to the building of community at the college and actively engage in our Faculty Association.
- 5. AWARENESS: We are aware of our rights and responsibilities under our collective agreement and in our association bylaws.
- 6. COLLEGIALITY: We promote collaboration and dialogue, support a culture of openness, and commit to the peaceful resolution of conflict and differences. We are helpful to each other.
- 7. PRIVACY: We respect the privacy and confidentiality of all members of the college community.
- 8. EXCELLENCE: We create an environment supportive of student learning and provide a high standard of educational and academic excellence.
