

CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the organization is Camosun College Faculty Association, hereinafter referred to as the Association.

ARTICLE II - OBLIGATIONS AND OBJECTIVES

The obligations and objectives of the Association are:

- 1. To hold certification and function as a trade union pursuant to the laws of BC
- 2. To function as a non-partisan, non-sectarian, and non-profit organization
- 3. To promote and protect the interests of members in their employment relationships
- 4. To represent members, bargain the members' contractual rights with Camosun College, monitor and administer the application of the collective agreement, and defend members' rights therein
- To advance education and promote the provision of the best possible educational services and supports at Camosun College
- 6. To promote, maintain, and defend academic freedom
- 7. To promote the professional development of the members
- 8. To promote the health, safety, and well-being of the members
- 9. To coordinate social and professional functions for the benefit of members
- 10. To foster a sense of community within Camosun College and encourage, promote and maintain responsible, cooperative working relations
- 11. To facilitate communication among its members and with the College Board of Governors, the administration, the student body, and the community
- 12. To represent the interests of its members to committees, boards, and other bodies responsible for decisions affecting faculty members and the delivery of education at Camosun College
- 13. To communicate and collaborate with other organizations whose interests are similar
- 14. To foster principles of social justice and sustainability in the local and global communities

ARTICLE III – JURISDICTION

The Association shall have jurisdiction over all faculty members of Camosun College except those excluded by the Labour Code and the Certificate of Bargaining Authority.
